RE: MOERANE COMMISSION

1. This letter is addressed to you on behalf of the Moerane Commission.
2. As you will be aware, having attended the meeting chaired by Judge S. Desai on Tuesday, 6 October 2009, when the members of the Commission were introduced to interested parties, the mandate of the Commission is set out in the terms of reference. As also indicated at that meeting, the Commission has been available to receive written and oral submissions from interested parties from Wednesday, 7 October 2009 to Friday, 9 October 2009, and will be available again from 12 October 2009 to 16 October 2009. The Commission will then adjourn and reconvene for further sittings from Monday, 9 November 2009 onwards.
3. The Commissioners would be greatly assisted in performing their mandate if all interested parties participate in the process and made submissions

(either written or oral) as to the matters falling within the Commission's terms of reference. The interested parties appear to include student leadership and also, should they wish, individual students who may wish to make submissions.

4. The Commissioners enquire whether student leadership, in particular representatives of the various student representative councils and the central SRC, either in their representative or personal capacities, intend to make submissions, and whether these will be in writing or oral. If a written submission is made, the Commissioners may request that this be elaborated upon or confirmed by a personal interview.
5. I accordingly request, on behalf of the Commission, that you indicate:
 - 5.1. Which persons (as also the constituency they represent) intend to make written and oral submissions; and
 - 5.2. By what date the written submissions will be received;
 - 5.3. When persons wish to make oral submissions, so that appointments can be made.
6. In addition to the above, the Commission will conduct inspections of those places on both the Bellville and Cape Town campuses at which the events of 30 July 2009 to 7 August 2009 took place. So as to ensure that the process is as inclusive as possible, it is requested that student leaders nominate not more than 3 persons who can accompany the Commissioners when they conduct the above viewing, it being preferable that the persons selected are persons who have personal knowledge of the events. Please include the names of the persons who have been put forward, and their

contact details, in your response so that the necessary arrangements can be made.

7. I am requested by the Commissioners to convey to you that they wish to obtain as broad a possible input from all interested persons with regard to matters falling within the terms of reference, and that your co-operation and assistance of the Commission would be appreciated.
